



Welcome to Belton




Natural Beauty & Outdoor Adventure!




Quick, Easy, & Reliable!


The HOP, a regional public transit system, services a nine county area, including our region. Private ride share services are also available.


34.1 YEARS MSA MEDIAN AGE




\$81,753 MSA AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD INCOME

MSA EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT




Diversified Industry & Available Talent!

Over the last five years, the area added 3,241 jobs, a 1.7% increase, and these are projected to continue to grow to 10,418 over the next five years.

The area has access to a steady and skilled labor pool with school districts, colleges and universities preparing and graduating approximately 5,000 students each year.

In addition, nearby Fort Cavazos, one of the largest U.S. military installations with a \$28.9 Billion impact to the Texas Economy, assists 154 highly skilled and trained soldiers with excellent work ethic reenter civilian life each month. 39% of these transitioning soldiers are looking for job opportunities in the region.
